

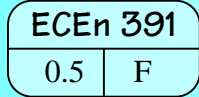
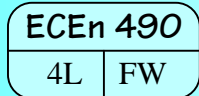
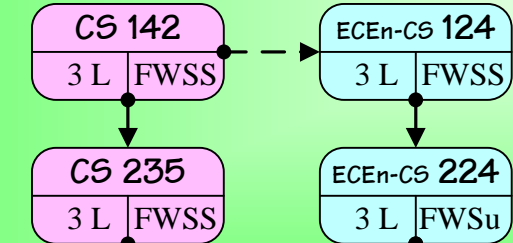
Brigham Young University Electrical Engineering Flowchart

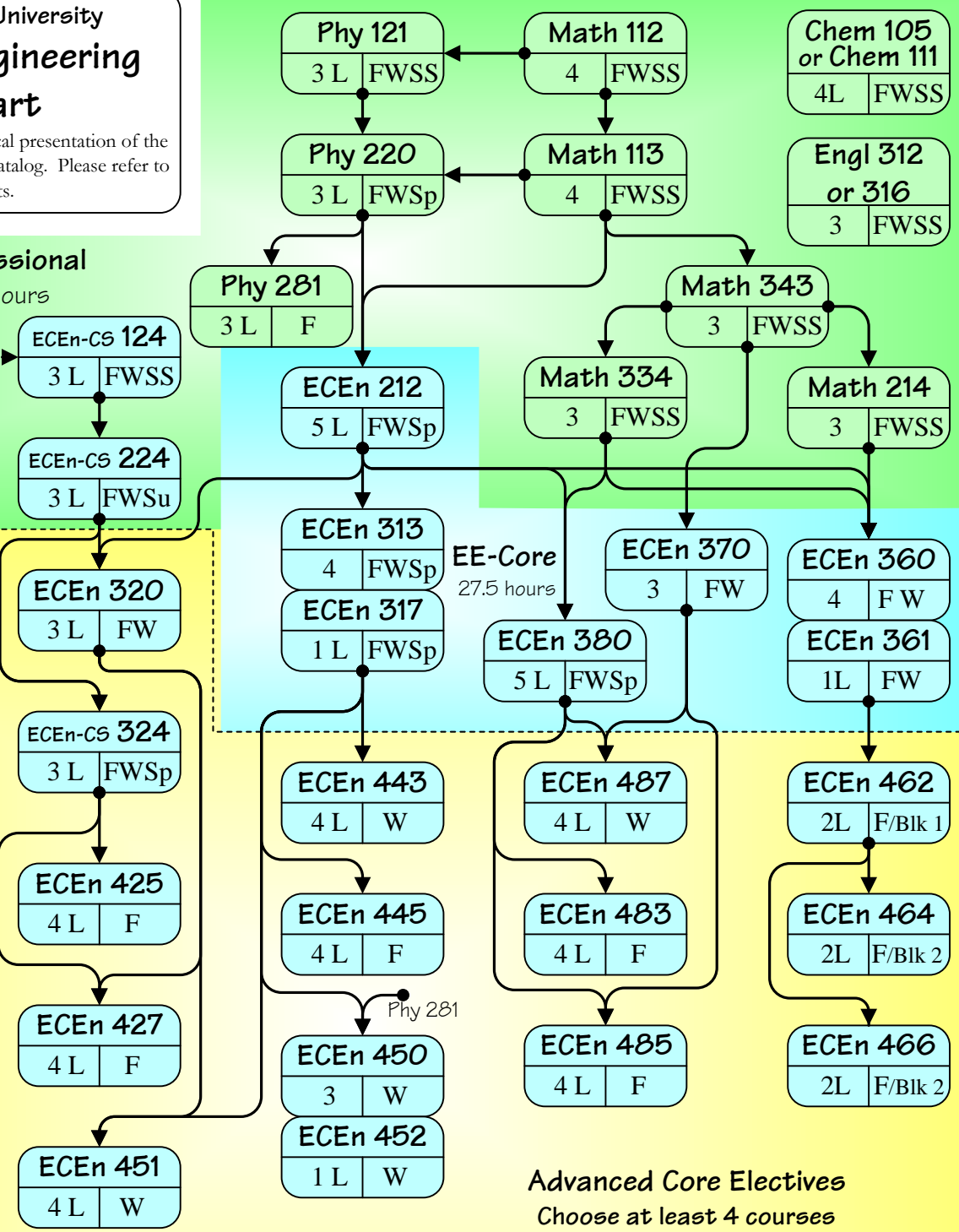

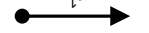
